Ramazan Hakkı Öztan is a historian of the modern Middle East, late Ottoman Balkans, and modern Turkey, broadly interested in the study of fin de siècle nationalisms, revolutionary politics, illicit markets, and borderlands. He received his Ph.D. in history in May 2016 from the University of Utah where he studied with the late Prof. Peter Sluglett. In 2015, he was a research fellow at the New Europe College, Bucharest, and he then worked as a lecturer at Istanbul Medipol University (2016-2017). Since October 2017, he has been working as a postdoctoral researcher in the Department of History at the University of Neuchâtel, Switzerland, with Prof. Jordi Tejel for a project funded by the European Research Council, titled “Towards a Decentred History of the Middle East: Transborder Spaces, Circulations, Frontier Effects and State Formation, 1920-1946.” His most recent articles appeared in *Past & Present* and *International Journal of Middle East Studies*.
